BACKGROUND

Old Veteran Construction, Inc. President and Chairman, Jose Maldonado grew up in Chicago Housing Authority [CHA] development, Trumbull Park, in the industrial neighborhood of South Deering, IL. South Deering is the largest neighborhood of the 77 community areas of the City of Chicago, located on the cities far south side.

At 16 years of age, Mr. Maldonado began developing his construction experience as a laborer and carpenter. As his experience grew, so did his aspirations. In 1986, Mr. Maldonado founded Old Veteran tuck-pointing, primarily focusing on Masonry Restoration and Rough Carpentry.

In 1993, Old Veteran tuck-pointing evolved into Old Veteran Construction, Inc. (OVC, Inc.), with Jose Maldonado remaining Principal and sole owner. In addition, OVC, Inc. became a Certified Minority Contractor (M.B.E./D.B.E.) with many City of Chicago Agencies and several other State of Illinois agencies.

In 1999, OVC, Inc., previously only performing Masonry Work, expanded its scope of services to include General Contracting. Since then OVC, Inc. has gained a wide range of successful project experience performing for both private and public clients:

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THE FUTURE

Possessing formidable capabilities, bonding capacity in excess of \$150M and aspirations to double its annual revenue over the next five (5) years, Mr. Maldonado has implemented a long term growth plan for OVC, Inc. Currently at \$80M+ in annual revenue, OVC, Inc. endeavors to grow at a controlled and sustainable rate over the next five (5) years to gross receipts in the \$200M range annually. With a proven track record performing at risk in the Chicagoland market primarily for public clients, OVC, Inc. perceives the next progression as not only targeting other geographies for public work, but also expanding into commercial markets and consulting services.

We have initiated our plans for national expansion and are currently performing or have successfully delivered projects in eleven (13) states (Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan, Missouri, New Mexico, New York, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Carolina & Wisconsin). Entering new geographic markets presents both unique challenges and unique opportunities. One of the challenges is identifying qualified subcontractors across the wide array of disciplines that a project presents. One way to achieve this is by forming partnerships locally with other general contractors that have interest in pursuing the same projects but benefit by teaming with OVC, Inc. In some cases, this partner could be a smaller firm that has the desire to grow but lacks the bonding capacity to pursue such projects on their own.

As a certified Minority Owned Business (M.B.E.) and a previous Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (D.B.E.), OVC, Inc. has been successful in pursuit of government projects at the city, county, state and federal levels but has left the commercial markets largely untapped. Our past performance on various types of projects makes us extremely well qualified to execute commercial work in markets including, but not limited to, retail, office, medical, industrial and residential including multi-family.

Historically OVC, Inc. has focused on at-risk General Contracting and self-performance of masonry, this background has given us a great deal of experience that lends itself naturally to entering the consulting market as a Program/Construction Manager. Our experience functioning within the operations of multiple government contracting authorities gives us unique insight to the strengths and weaknesses of various operating models as well as software systems. Additionally, given that many municipalities and other government entities are managing a portfolio of aged facilities in need of life-safety, ADA and exterior upgrades, our self-performance and GC experience in these areas make us uniquely qualified to oversee such programs or projects on behalf of an owner. Most recently, OVC, Inc. assembled a team of experienced consulting firms to pursue a Program Management opportunity the with the City of Chicago Department of Fleet and Facilities Management and are awaiting the City's decision with regards to selection of a consulting team.

The OVC, Inc. model of workplace diversity and job creation within the communities we serve, has been paramount to our growth thus far, and we are confident that it will serve to be a solid foundation for our future plans.
