



# Certification of Compliance With A Drug Free Workplace

This statement is provided pursuant to the Drug-Free workplace Act of 1988.

The unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensation, possession, or use of a controlled substance is prohibited on the premises of the Portsmouth Metropolitan Housing Authority of Portsmouth, Ohio. Appropriate actions which may include termination of contract will be taken against Portsmouth Metropolitan Housing Authority Contractors for violation of this prohibition.

"Controlled substance" for the purposes of this Statement means a controlled substance listed in schedules \* through V of section 202 of the Controlled Substances Act (21 U.S.C. Section 812), and as further defined by federal regulations (21 CFR Sections 1300.11 through .15). This list includes but is not limited to, heroin, marijuana, PCP, cocaine and amphetamines.

A condition of contracting for work under grant received by Portsmouth Metropolitan Housing Authority from any federal agency is that each contractor directly engaged in the performance of work funded by such a grant will:

1. Abide by the terms of this statement, and
2. Notify Portsmouth metropolitan Housing Authority of his or her or of any individual in the contractor's employment, including subcontractors, of his or her criminal drug stature conviction for any violation occurring in the workplace of Portsmouth Metropolitan Housing Authority no later than five days after such conviction.
  - a. "Conviction" means a finding of guilt (including a plea of nolo contendere) or imposition of sentence, or both, by any judicial body charged with the responsibility to determine violation of the Federal or State (including the District of Columbia) criminal drug statues.
  - b. "Criminal drug statue" means a criminal statute involving the manufacture, distribution, dispensation, use of possession of any controlled substance.

A sanction will be imposed on any contractor or individual in contractor's employment, including all subcontractors, so convicted. Within thirty (30) days after receiving notice of the conviction, the Portsmouth Metropolitan Housing Authority will take appropriate action against such contractor, up to and including termination of contract.

This notice supplements, and does not replace all other certifications of compliance to rules and laws applicable to all individuals, companies, corporations, agencies, associations, and any or all other entities performing work for the Portsmouth Metropolitan Housing Authority.
