NOTICE TO PROPOSERS:

- A. This Addendum shall be considered part of the Contract Documents for the above mentioned project as though it had been issued at the same time and shall be incorporated integrally therewith. Where provisions of the following supplementary data differ from those of the original Contract Documents, this Addendum shall govern and take precedence.
- B. Offerors are hereby notified that they shall make any necessary adjustment in their estimates on account of this Addendum. It will be construed that each Bidder's documentation is submitted with full knowledge of all modifications and supplemental data specified herein.

Addendum #1

- 1. The Due Date for Pest Control Services is extended to Tuesday, August 14, 2018 by 3:00 PM ET.
- 2. This addendum is issued prior to the receipt of proposals to provide for inclusion of the requirement of Prevailing Wage. For Maintenance work, the agency and its contractors may pay to maintenance laborers and mechanics no less than the wage rate indicated for the type of work that they actually perform. This is called the Maintenance Wage Rate. A task that is quoted on the Price Proposal Form should include all labor and materials needed to complete the work. Labor will include payments of prevailing wage rates as determined by LMHA and the Department of Labor and Industries. The contractor will sign a fixed unit price contract with LMHA to include all work (labor) and services. The Prevailing Wage is defined as the hourly wage, usual benefits and overtime, paid in the largest city in each county, to the majority of workers, laborers, and mechanics. Payroll records may be audited yearly to determine that the DOL Maintenance Wage Rate requirements were met.
