Q & A's

1. Per Scope of service on Page # 16 items A) through E) will there be one or several awards?

Response: The RFP permits HACEP to select one or more title service providers. The proposed staff recommendation, pending final approval, will be to select multiple, or several, qualified service providers to create a rotational list to be used on an "as needed basis" as such transactions occur.

2. What does RAD stand for?

Response: Rental Assistance Demonstration program, a federal housing program that permits public housing authorities like HACEP to convert older properties in need of renovation or being re-built into new housing. The RAD program also includes changing from an older, less-efficient subsidy program (Public Housing) to a newer, more-effective subsidy program (such as Project-Based Rental Assistance or Project-Based Vouchers).

3. Why are the RAD development projects excluded from this RFP?

Response: RAD transactions are unique and complex real estate transactions because, among other reasons, they involve multiple sources of public and private financing, usually involve up to two or three different federal- and state-regulated subsidies, involve a multitude of partners and a different ownership model, and are led by separate developers or co-developers. As a result of the complexities, including the fact HACEP itself is not the customer in a RAD transaction and for other reasons too long to go into here, management wishes to make it clear that this RFP does not include the RAD conversion transactions, which are already in progress and anticipated to conclude in 2020. Rather, this RFP is limited to the ongoing and recurring need for HACEP to purchase, sell, acquire, trade, or otherwise dispose of real estate, outside of its RAD transactions.
