

ADDENDUM NO. 1 September 11, 2020

Parkway Place Broadband Submitted requests and questions Bid #1531

- 1. Key differences between RFP #1531 and RFP #1527 issued in August.
 - The answers to questions and requests for additional information from the previous RFP have been incorporated into this one.
 - The RFP is seeking to provide Broadband for two years without any additional commitment to provide services to Parkway Place residents at a guaranteed price after the two years. The chosen ISP, however, will be able to market their services to residents after the two-year period ends.
 - The definition of Broadband has changed raising the minimum speed requirement.
 - Bidders interested in utilizing Louisville Metro Government's fiber assets must make contact with the city and begin preliminary discussions prior to submitting bids. LMHA will check with Louisville Metro Government it see if this has happened.
 - The Scoring has changed. Experience & Qualifications and Timeliness are now threshold items with no points assigned. The Fee Proposal is now worth up to 75 points and 25 points have been assigned to Broadband speed.
- 2. Do bidders who previously responded to RFP #1527 have to provide new original signed and notarized forms?
 - A new signed and notarized Affidavit of Non-Collusion must be included in the submittal
 - Since the Project Specific Information section has changed it must be signed.
 - If the information for forms in Sections B and M has not changed, copies from the previous submittal should be included in the new submittal, but if the information has changed, new signed and if needed notarized versions would need to be submitted just for the changed forms.
 - An original submittal with two copies is still required.
