## **QUESTION 1:**

In the specification, there is the inclusion of a **side wall grab bar in the bath.** But some of the baths don't have a sidewall. Do I suppose to provide a foldable grab bar, which can be a good fit for those bathrooms? Or should we go with a normal one?

#### **FWHS Response:**

As listed on page 6 under **5. Material**, the correct grab bar is the Brushed Stainless Steel Concealed screw grab bars as manufactured by Glacier Bay or approved equal. All bathtubs have three walls: (1) head wall were the faucet is located, (2) sidewall typically were the soap dish is installed, (3) and a back wall. The head wall and the back wall is where the curtain rod is installed also. On the sidewall, there will be two (2) grab bars installed.





# **QUESTION 2:**

There is no mention of selective demolition.

#### **FWHS Response:**

The only demo will be installation of the blocking as indicated on page 5, under **5. Bathrooms** items iii, iv, and v, the contractor shall install blocking in the walls which you will have to demo sheetrock to install the blocking at the toilet and tubs.
